

Case Study

54 year old white female with PAINFUL ARTHRITIS and a RASH



The patient was on Celebrex for years, but still has pain in her joints. She was also on multiple medications for her psoriasis, including steroids, but still had occasional breakouts. Other medications she took were elocon cream, ziac and gemfibrozil. She also has been diagnosed with hypertension and hypercholesterolemia. SpectraCell's micronutrient testing indicated deficiencies in vitamin B12, vitamin D, Selenium and Spectrox. **Based upon her deficiencies, she was administered the following treatment protocol:**

1) Prescriptions for all of the above individual supplements

Clinical Outcome:

Since starting the vitamins, her arthritis pain is gone. She also no longer has the psoriasis lesions that were so bad, they were bleeding. She has not seen her dermatologist in a year and no longer needs expensive dermatology medications.

Conclusion:
